

What qualifies as a course by the VR/LÍV funds?

Clearly defined beginning and end

Characterized by accessibility of information

Open enrollment

Follows a prepared plan or definition

Counselling or guidance work do not qualify for grants

When is a course eligible for a grant?

Eligible Studies

Credit-based studies

Leads to increased rights/competence

Language courses
public tutoring as well as private

Eligible Courses

Fits the above definitions of a course

Job-related courses
if unclear, please provide explanations

Counselling, guidance work and any treatment/therapy do not qualify

Eligible Self-Empowerment

Fits the above definitions of a course

Must be preventative rather than treatment for an existing condition

Job-related coaching
amounting to 12 hours per calendar year; number of hours must be specified on invoices

Eligible Online Courses

Fits the above definitions of a course

Job-related courses
if unclear, please provide explanations

Online subscriptions to platforms which offer a range of job-related courses

Eligible Conference

Conference grants, covering work-related conference fees
if unclear, please provide explanations

Neither accommodation nor meals at work-related conferences qualify for reimbursement

Please include your itinerary and a link to the website of the conference in question with your application

Leisure Courses

Fits the above definitions of a course

Beginner courses that fit the above definitions qualify for grants, but continuous practicing/training does not

Private tutoring at leisure-based courses, active physiological and psychological treatments/therapy do not qualify for grants
